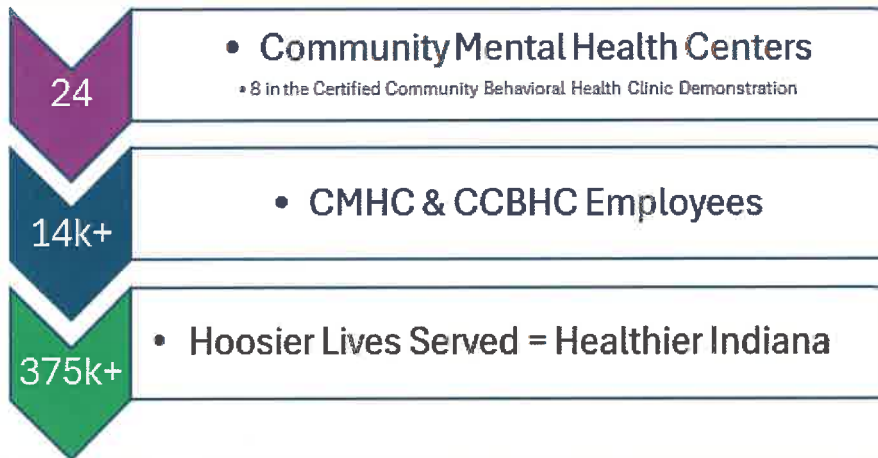

Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:

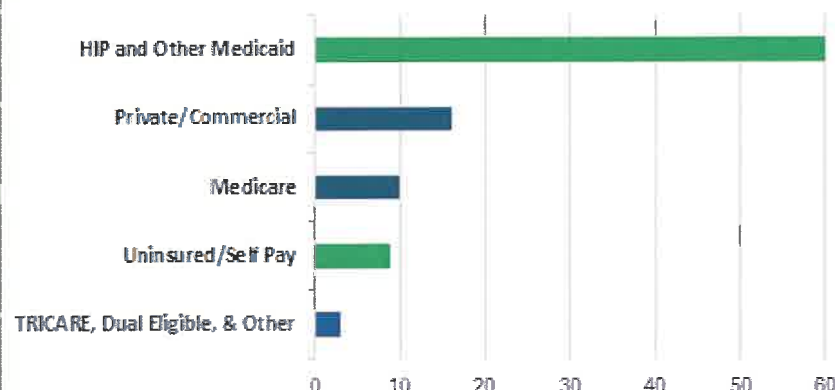
1. Generalized Anxiety Disorder
